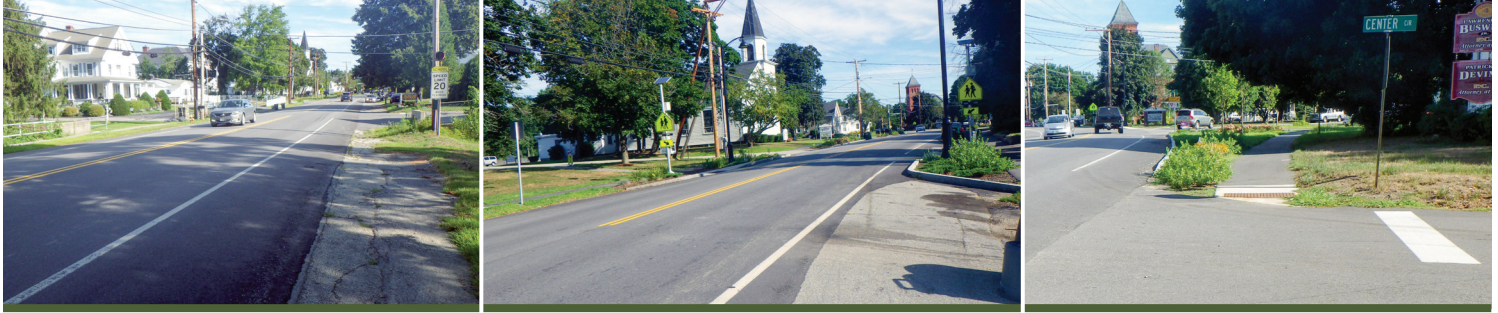


Plaistow 40641 – Main St (NH 121A) Traffic Calming and Safety Improvement Project



Purpose:

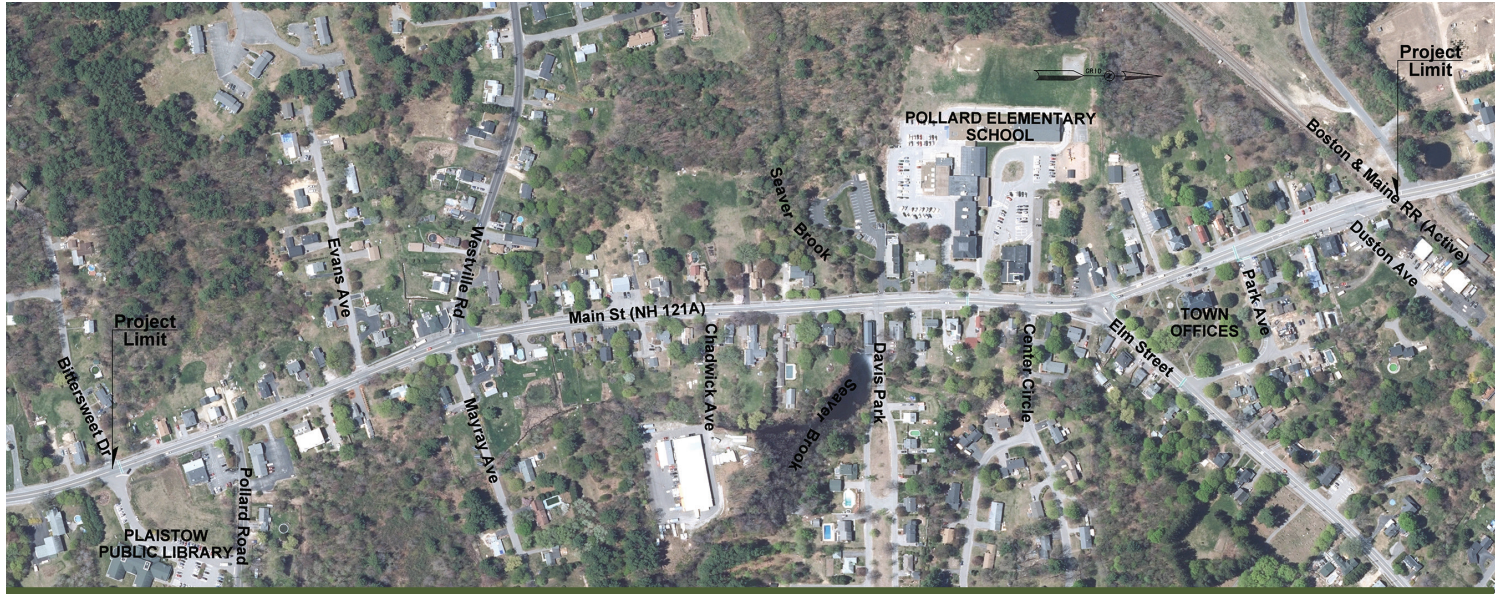
A Main Street Traffic Calming Study (2011), performed by the Rockingham Planning Commission for the Town of Plaistow, recommended implementation of a comprehensive traffic calming program along Main Street (NH Route 121A), including measures to slow traffic, discourage use as a heavy vehicle cut-through, and improve mobility for non-motorized travel, with a final overall objective to improve the safety along Main Street.

Status:

The NHDOT is currently collecting existing condition data, such as topographic survey and right-of-way marker locations, limits of wetlands and invasive species, traffic counts, etc. This effort will be followed by the development of a range of alternatives for improvements to meet the purpose of the project. As alternatives are developed, the NHDOT will hold public meetings (Fall/Winter 2020) to engage the public and seek input. Coordination and collection of field data will be ongoing through the duration of the project, which is scheduled to advertise for construction in the Fall 2024.
