Dear Mr. Sires:

The NH Department of Transportation is developing a pavement preservation project along US 302 as part of our Federal Resurfacing Program that we wanted to make you and the Public Officials aware of.

The proposed improvements along US 302 will begin at the intersection of NH 16 and continue easterly approximately 2.5 miles to the NH 113 intersection. This project constitutes the second phase of the pavement rehabilitation process along this corridor, as the most deficient segments of this roadway are included as part of the 2022 District Resurfacing program and is scheduled to be completed by this fall. The roadway will be further rehabilitated under the future project by placing a pavement leveling course to reshape the roadway followed by placement of a 1-1/2 inch full width pavement overlay (across travel lanes and shoulders) to restore the riding surface and increase the structural capacity of the facility. Minor guardrail and drainage improvements are also anticipated as a part of the project, which is currently planned for advertising on February 23, 2023 with an anticipated completion of the fall of 2023.

Throughout the duration of the project, and at the discretion of the Department, uniformed officers and/or flaggers will be used to control traffic, as appropriate. Additionally, portable changeable message signs may be used to notify motorists in advance of upcoming work, detours, and for messages during construction. Included are copies of the Municipal Work Zone Agreement (MWZA), which are conveyed to municipalities as an acknowledgement that the Department will have the authority to control traffic through the work zone for the duration of the

project. Please sign the enclosed documents and return to me in the self addressed stamped envelope provided.
