QUALIFICATIONS-BASED SELECTION CONTRACT

POSTING DATE: July 11, 2024

SCOPE OF WORK:

One (1) On-Call Agreement, anticipated to have a maximum value of \$3,000,000 over a five-year term, is needed to provide on-call survey and utility services during the design and/or construction phase of the project.

The project services needed may include any and all aspects of survey and utility services including topographic survey, mapping, boundary survey services, and registry plans for the FE Everett Turnpike (FEET, I-293) in Manchester including NH Route 3A and Manchester City streets. The project includes approximately 3.4 miles of the FEET beginning north of Exit 5 and proceeding northerly approximately 1.3 miles north of the existing Exit 7. The project also includes two interchanges (Exits 6 and 7), new connector roads, and the intersecting secondary roadways at each interchange and overpass. The Professional Survey and Utility Services Agreement shall be conducted under the supervision of a NH Licensed Land Surveyor and in conformance with the NHDOT Survey Technical Standards Manual, 2017. Assignments are expected to include but not limited to:

- Boundary survey services prescribing to the Department's methodology, e.g., determining and mapping limited access, controlled access and existing right-of-way and property lines of the corridor for use at a public hearing.
- Title work in accordance with NH Bar Association Title Standards and NHDOT policy ROW layout and plan development, including any necessary survey work, for determining and documenting the existing highway right-of-way in a manner suitable for recording at the Registry of Deeds.
- A topographic survey to be furnished in a format to be approved by the Department, for engineering design.
- Existing utility mapping and location services requiring project coordination with NHDOT and utility companies for subsurface and above-ground utilities. The Tasks anticipated will follow Subsurface Utility Engineering (SUE) Quality Levels to document the project utilities.

- Supplemental survey requests as required to supplement design and construction.
- Providing and setting monumentation.

The assignments are expected to be phased.

Consultants submitting a Letter of Interest will be assessed on their capability and capacity to perform the above-mentioned services, experience of the firm and staff, availability to respond rapidly to on-call assignments, on-time delivery, and current workload with the Department. This work will require Professional Engineer and Land Surveyor licensure in the State of New Hampshire.

Task orders assigned under this agreement will be negotiated as either a cost plus-fixed-fee, or a lump sum method of compensation.
